



## Criteria for Khazanah IHH Healthcare Fund Programme

1. Financial standing/position of applicant must be reviewed by a **Registered Malaysian NGO**.
2. Applicant must be recommended by a doctor of Pantai and Gleneagles Hospital.
3. Household income not more than RM 5,000 per month
4. Salary slightly higher than RM5,000 per month will be based on case to case basis e.g.
  - \* **number of dependents**
  - \* **number of family members who are sick or handicapped**
  - \* **cost of treatment**
5. Applicant/Parents/Guardian must be able to provide documents for a complete application (if applicable)
  - \* **Applicant's/Parents'/Legal Guardians' NRIC**
  - \* **Child's birth cert**
  - \* **3 months' salary slip or income tax return statement**
  - \* **EPF statement**
6. Applicant/Parents/Legal Guardians must allow reviewers to take photos of living conditions, etc.

## Criteria for Treatment

1. Covers primary treatment and any follow-ups related to the primary treatment. Does not include any other medical condition that the individual is born with or caused by any other external factors not related to the actual treatment.
2. The treatment should be provided by **ONLY PANTAI AND GLENEAGLES HOSPITALS**
3. Applicable to acute treatment lasting 6 weeks and below.
4. Special cases will be taken into consideration.

## Guidelines

1. Referral by NGO and/or Consultant
2. Interview and Submission of Appeal Form by NGO
3. Indication of case acceptance by a Pantai/Gleneagles Hospital Consultant
4. Financial estimation is given to NGO based on treatment plan by accepting consultant, for hospital charges and consultant's professional fees
5. Confirmation of case acceptance and coverage under Khazanah Fund by PHB Management
6. Patient scheduled for treatment/undergoes treatment/procedure
7. Upon discharge, hospital to submit final bills and Medical Reports to PHB Management
